MISSED APPOINTMENT POLICIES

When you schedule your appointment, you have reserved this time in our schedule, and we have placed it aside to meet with you. If you must cancel or change your appointment, we require that you contact our office at least 24 hours in advance. To cancel a Monday appointment, cancellation is expected on the prior business day, which is Friday. We charge a \$50 fee for no shows or late cancellations. These charges are not covered by insurance and are the responsibility of the patient or guardian.

Consecutive missed appointments (2 or more no shows or late cancellations in a row) may result in termination of services.

Unpaid balances on your account are due on or before your next scheduled appointment. If you have not paid in advance, you should be prepared to pay these fees at the time you check in for your next appointment.

Our staff will attempt to notify you of your upcoming appointment. However, this is provided as a *courtesy only*. You are still responsible for remembering your appointment. Not receiving this notice or receiving it after the 24-hour time limit does not excuse you from this responsibility.

We understand that there may be extenuating circumstances that excuse a missed appointment. If you believe that we made an error in scheduling or that your situation merits special consideration for a no show/late cancellation fee, please submit a written explanation to our office. Thank you for taking the time to review our missed appointment policies. We hope making them clear will eliminate any misunderstanding if they need to be applied during your treatment.
